Fifty eight aircraft are listed in the New Allocation section this month and it is interesting to break this down into groups to give an insight into the trends affecting the Australian aviation marketplace. Local content is supplied by no less than ten new Gippsland Airvans, a great tribute to this small but effective aircraft manufacturer from rural Victoria, another Kavanagh hot air balloon for Hot Air of Cairns - their eighth, and six amateur built aircraft. The home built machines comprise of two US designs, Vans RV-6 and Rand KR-2, along with two European designed Europas and two Australian designs, Corby Starlet and Spiffy. The Corby is proof that a forty year old design can still be a practical flying machine in a hi-tech world and nothing is known at all about Adam Barrow's Spiffy, XSL.

As usual, Robinson and Eurocopter are the only manufacturers importing new helicopters this month with three R44 Raven IIs and an AS350B3 Squirrel listed, however used helicopter imports are much more interesting with two Jet Rangers, two Squirrels, an Enstrom and Kiowa. CLD brings the number of Enstroms flying in Australia to eleven whilst OSO is the fourth Kiowa now flying in Australia, three of which have been converted for civil use by Tom Osbourne and remain with his company in Tasmania.

New, single engined imports are well represented with three Cessna 172Rs and a Cessna 182T for Western Australian Cessna agents Airflite, a Beech A36 Bonanza and a Cirrus SR20, both now Victoria

based, and another Pilatus PC-12 turboprop for the RFDS. The single engined turboprop market in Australia has increased dramatically over the last few years with 30 Cessna 208 Caravans, 23 Pilatus PC-12s, 18 of which are operated by the RFDS, and 2 SOCATA TBM700s now flying in this country.

On the heavier side Sunstate Airlines and Eastern Australia Airlines have added Dash 8s to their fleets with SBW becoming the thirteenth of its type in the Sunstate fleet and TQD and TQK bringing the number of Dash 8s operated by Eastern to twenty three. Sunstate and Eastern, both subsidiaries of Qantas, have now standardized on the type and the total number of Dash 8s now flying in Australia is 48. VOU brings the Virgin Blue Boeing 737 fleet to 40 whilst MZL is the first Learjet 60 on the local register. The Learjet 60 is a development of the model 55 which was designed to answer criticism about the small Learjet cabin compared the larger executive jets that were on the market. The 55 and 60 series have a "stand-up" cabin, capable of carrying up to ten passengers and two crew, and a NASA designed supercritical wing, which includes winglets. The winglets replaced the famous Learjet wing tip fuel tanks and mean that all fuel has to be carried internally.

Three aircraft have Returned to the Register this issue - Bell 412HP CFT, Auster Autocar DNM and Grumman Trainer ETR.

CFT was originally imported during December 1994 and was operated by Careflight as a fully equipped "medivac" chopper until it was exported to Taiwan in September 2003. From Taiwan it found its way to India from where it has been shipped back to Australia. There have only been three Bell 412HPs operated in Australia - the other two, ESA and ESD, being used by the Queensland Department of Emergency Services. A development of the Bell 212, the 412 uses a four blade rotor with a modified rotor head, and is produced in four variants - 412, 412EP, 412HP and 412SP. The 412EP has an upgraded 1800shp PT6T-3D Twin Pac turboshaft engine whilst the 412HP is fitted with the PT6T-3BE engine and the 412SP has extra fuel capacity and a higher gross take-off weight.

DNM was one of eighty two Auster J/5B Autocars built by Auster Aircraft Ltd in the UK between 1950 and 1957 and fitted with a de Havilland Gipsy Major I engine. Interestingly, almost half of the J/5B Autocars built came to Australia and New Zealand with fourteen still flying in this part of the world. DNM was delivered new, to the North Queensland Aero Club during September 1955 and later saw service with Bush Pilots Airways. It was de-registered in June 1964 but returned to the register two years later, this time as KJB. It was again de-registered in December 1974 when owned by CJ Pratt of Gympie but is back, using its original markings of DNM, and now owned by Ron Unwin of Kirwan, Queensland.

Grumman Trainer ETR has returned to the register after more than six year of inactivity. The aircraft was de-registered during September 1997 and was partially stripped in preparation for a major refurbishment by its owner Steve Franklin-Bull. However, the rebuild did not go ahead and it was sold "as is" two years later to Gympie Aircraft Maintenance as a long term restoration project. With the refurbishment now complete the Trainer is back on the register and is a common sight in the skies over Gympie and the Sunshine Coast.

Thirty eight aircraft make up the Deletions listing this month with almost half of these being exported. The move to New Zealand of Miles Messenger ZMM is by far the biggest loss to Australian aviation heritage. ZMM was painstakingly restored during the early 1990s after thirty years of storage and was the only example of its type in Australia. The Messenger was designed and built by Miles Aircraft of Woodley, England, and was a development of the M28 Mercury. Miles was well known for its Hawk, Whitney Straight and Falcon series of single engined, wooden, monoplanes before the war, and its Magister trainer during the war. The Mercury was a four place, low wing, cabin monoplane with a twin fin tail unit, retractable tailwheel undercarriage and fitted with a 130hp Gipsy Major I engine. It was designed for use by the British Army as an Air Observation Post but only a small number were built before it was superceded by the Messenger. The prototype Mercury was fitted with a new wing and fixed undercarriage to become the prototype Messenger whilst production aircraft had a triple fin and a 140hp Gipsy Major engine. Peace cut short the Messengers military career so a production line was set up in Northern Ireland to built civil machines fitted with 150hp Blackburn Cirrus Major III power plants. In all ninety three Messengers were built with sixty five of these being the Mark 2A - civil, four seat version with 150hp engine.

ZMM was first registered in the UK as G-AJVL on May 30 1947 and came to Australia three years later. It was originally registered BJM on December 28 1950 to Hecker and Company of Maryborough but was grounded by the DCA thirteen years later after problems were found with the glued joints of many wooden aircraft of the day. Thirty years later the Messenger was back in the air after a long and expensive restoration program using modern gluing techniques. Mike Apps obtained the aircraft during October 1997 and re-registered it ZMM but unfortunately Mike has now sold it to Mr DJ Cowrie of Auckland, New Zealand where it has taken up "period marking" of ZK-CMM.

Other exports of note are the first two of four Gippsland Airvans, BNL and BOI, for the Kalimantan Provincial Government at Samarinda, Indonesia, with FDR and JYN to follow shortly. Soundsair of Picton, New Zealand, have also received an Airvan, BQR/ZK-KLC. Soundsair presently use a Cessna Caravan and Cessna Stationair on a regular shuttle between Picton and Wellington, linking the South and North Islands at their closest point. The Airvan is becoming popular in New Zealand with Soundsair, Glenorchy Air Services of Queenstown, Air Safaris of Tekapo and Wings Over Whales at Kaikoura all successfully operating the type. Other exports to New Zealand include Eurocopter EC120B Colibri CXX, which is now flying as ZK-HEK with Gatsuurt Mining of Takaka and Boeing 737s TAZ and VOO. TAZ is now ZK-JNB and is the eighth Qantas Boeing 737 to be transferred to the airline's New Zealand domestic operation, Jetconnect, whilst VOO has become the first aircraft in the Pacific Blue Airlines fleet and is now flying as ZK-PBA.

The USA continues to be a major destination for Australian aircraft with Airvan BQT now flying as N606AV with the USAF Auxiliary Civil Air Patrol and the two Beech King Airs, FDW and FOP, previously operated by the RFDS, being advertised for sale

through Southern Wings Aircraft Sales of Bethany, Oklahoma, and registered N278SW and N277SW respectively. Boeing 737 CZQ has returned to CIT Leasing of New York and is now marked as N446CT whilst Qantas Boeing 767 EAL has been registered N770WD. The registering of EAL comes as a surprise as it was ferried to Mojave for long term storage and was expected to remain unregistered for a while. It appears that a sale is now imminent.

NTL is the last of Impulse Airlines' ten Beech 1990Ds to go to South Africa and EKG is the third Regional Express SAAB 340s to be returned to Sweden, to be replaced by American sourced examples. Cessna 208 Caravan KLP is now domiciled in Thailand although it is believed that it is on a short term contract and will therefore return to Australia at the end of its tour of duty.

Agusta A109A MQB, which was previously owned by Helicare Investments of Mapleton, Qld, has been withdrawn from use with the official notation being "CoR Holder stopped being the entitled person" seeming to indicate that the aircraft's ownership is in limbo. No doubt the Agusta will find a new owner shortly, whether it be within Australia or overseas, whereupon it will be reported in this column. The same notation has been used for the cancellation of Skyfox ZVC but it is likely that this aircraft will be transferred to the Australian Ultralight Federation register as so many Skyfoxes have been in recent months

No real surprises in the Changes of CoR Holders section this month with the main interest being the transfer of eight aircraft from the Trailfinders fleet to Hinterland Aviation. Hinterland is a subsidiary of Trailfinders and the move brings all but two of the groups Cairns based aircraft under the Hinterland Aviation banner. Cessna Caravans TFS and CVN remain with Trailfinders whilst Hinterland now boast two Commander 500s, two Cessna 402s, a Super King Air, Islander, Cessna Caravan, Cessna Titan and Cessna Stationair.

Harvey McBain has taken delivery of the rare DH84A Dragon AON (see Warbirds, Vintage and Veteran last month), Aviation Centre of Bankstown has sold Navajo Chieftain AVF to Crane Air, and Geoff Hunt has acquired elderly Beech Queen Airs AMQ and MWK. The Queen Airs have become the largest aircraft in Geoff's fleet which comprises of four Beech 36 Bonanzas, a Navajo, Aerostar and Cessna U206G - all based at Darwin.

The brand new 2004 issue of the Australian Aviation Civil Aircraft Register is now available. This is the only publication that lists the CASA register in an easy to read tabulated format and includes registration, type, construction number and C of R Holders's name and address. As with previous years we have included aircraft registered with the Gliding Federation of Australia, the Hang Gliding Federation of Australia and the Australian Ultralight Federation.
